Dress Code Policy

The key words to describe the Cranleigh Sixth Form Dress Code are smart, polished, crisp and professional. Pupils should appear business-like in their appearance and should demonstrate cultural sensitivity.

Ladies Dress Code

- Dark below-the-knee skirt suit or dark trouser suit with optional tights. Slight patterns/checks allowed.
- Dark coloured dresses can be worn but must cover the shoulders and reach the knees.
- Coloured formal shirts or blouses. Collared shirts may have a fine pinstripe.
 Can be covered by suit jacket, plain black V- neck pullover or black/ navy buttoned cardigan. Tops can be long or short sleeved but must cover the shoulders.
- Black polished shoes with heels less than 5cm measured on the outside from top of heel to floor – no stilettos. Casual footwear such as Converse must not be worn.

Gentleman's Dress Code

- Gentlemen have the option to wear a dark colored suit. Slight patterns are allowed.
- Chinos with a button-up shirt and jacket may be worn
- Cranleigh Sixth Form Tie (available from the Uniform Shop) must be worn.
- Formal collared shirts may be white or light blue can have a fine pinstripe.
- Black or navy plain v-neck/pullover may be worn. Top buttons should be done up and ties worn properly.
- Black/brown polished shoes.

Jewelry and make up

- Hair dyed in unnatural colours is not permitted
- Jewellery and make up should be discreet
