



1) EMSAT EXAMINATIONS:

Any Sixth Former who is considering tertiary studies within the UAE (whether Emirati or Non-Emirati), as well as those who may wish to work at a UAE Government owned organisation, should register for and sit the EMSAT exam. Please click [here](#) for further information about the EMSAT. For students opting to register for the EMSAT exams, Rebecca Rowley (Exams Officer) will be in touch in due course to assist with the process. Once registered, it will be the student's responsibility to prepare for, and attend, the exams as instructed by the MOE.

2) ARABIC:

Students who are new to Cranleigh or who chose to continue with Arabic in Year 11 have the option to discontinue studying Arabic in the Sixth Form if they are a Non-Native Arabic speaker and they do not require Shahadat Al-Thanawiya Al-Amma (Equivalency)*.
